

Garbage & Recycling Policy

Whereas, all taxpayers contribute to the Village budget;

Whereas, the Village Board of Trustees wish to be fair with all its taxpayers;

Whereas, the service of weekly garbage and recycling pick up saves village taxpayers from contracting with private sanitation services;

Whereas the Village of Lyons Falls participates in the Lewis County Recycling Program and request that the residents and businesses follow the County's guidelines for recycling;

Let it be resolved that the Village of Lyons Falls will provide weekly sanitation services to all residents and businesses with the following guidelines:

Section 1: Each residence or business is allowed a maximum of four (4) thirty gallon garbage bags for the weekly garbage pick-up;

Section 2: Garbage bags should be in a covered metal or plastic container thereby preventing animals and birds from ripping apart the bags;

Section 3: Recycled Paper & magazines are to be tied in bundles; put all glass, tin and plastic together in one trash can, not in bags;

Section 4: Residences and Businesses are to have their garbage cans and recyclables ready for pick up by 7:00 am at designated day; business pickups are to be at their trash sites, some behind their business and some beside their buildings.

Section 5: If pick up is not on the scheduled day because of a holiday or emergency the Mayor or designee will notify the local radio station, DPW superintendent, and Trustees;

Section 6: The Village will bid the sanitation service out on an annual basis.
